**PROGRAM OVERVIEW:**

The Nestlé USA Logistics Summer Internship Program provides a meaningful, paid summer internship experience to high-potential college students who are interested in a Logistics career with the world's largest food company. For approximately 12 weeks over the summer, Logistics Interns are assigned substantive projects and receive developmental feedback to gain a better understanding of the role of Logistics at Nestlé USA. At the end, we hope to meet one of the key objectives of the internship program: to develop students into high-caliber candidates for full-time employment with Nestlé USA Logistics.

**WHO WE ARE LOOKING FOR:**

Eligibility criteria:

- Preferred majors: Supply Chain, Logistics & Transportation, Operations, and Business/Finance. Other majors include: Economics, Industrial Engineering, Mathematics, Statistics, and related disciplines.
- Prior internship or job in Supply Chain, Finance or Engineering. Also, individuals with an applicable internship/job in sales/marketing may be considered.

- Drive for improvement
- Ability to create new ideas to operate more efficiently

**HIGH-IMPACT PROJECTS:**

As a Nestlé intern, your projects have measurable goals and objectives which are achievable during your tenure. Examples of past projects:

- Outline a new product forecasting process for the demand planning team

**SUPERVISED, YET SELF-DIRECTED:**

Continuous, constructive performance feedback is critical to the success of our internship program. Formal evaluations will be included at the middle and end of your internship; informal, constructive input will be provided frequently.

**MENTOR AND BUDDY PROGRAM:**

To ensure the success of the program and enhance your experience, you will be assigned a mentor and a buddy with whom you will keep in close contact throughout the summer. The mentor is typically a senior logistics professional who shares his/her experiences and presents a broad overview of their specific division, as well as provides overall coaching and guidance. The buddy is typically a junior-level logistics professional who serves as an ongoing resource to familiarize and integrate you into our organization.
