- ✓ Student must not require sponsorship now or in the future for employment status (e.g. H-1B visa status)
- ✓ Demonstrated leadership skills
- ✓ Holds a leadership position in a diverse on- or off-campus student organization
- ✓ Committed to a career in one of the following business functions: Finance, Human Resources, Manufacturing, Product Development (Food Technology), Sales, Supply Chain (Logistics, Packaging, Purchasing)
- ✓ Must not be a previous participant in the Nestlé USA Leadership Symposium
